

The Prince William County Fairground Management has new regulations which apply in 2017 and later to all users of the Fairgrounds, and more particularly apply for all motor vehicle and towed trailer parking, and loading to and unloading from any motor vehicle or towed trailer during the upcoming Manassas HamFest for Vendors with space in the Commercial Building or in any Show Barn building.

Under the new regulations, no Vendor motor vehicle or towed trailer is allowed in (or to enter into) the Commercial Building or in (or to enter into) any of the Show Barn buildings. Vendors with space inside the Commercial Building are required to unload and load either at the East front or South side doors of the Commercial Building. The North side door of the Commercial Building may not be used for loading/unloading.

After Vendors have unloaded their motor vehicles or trailers, they will be directed to park them in the main Parking Lot area outside the perimeter fence. No Vendor parking of motor vehicles or trailers (except while actual unloading or loading is in progress) will be allowed anywhere inside the perimeter fence, including specifically on or next to any of the service roads inside the perimeter fence, next to the Commercial Building, next to the Arts & Crafts building or in front of any of the Show Barn buildings. Vendors should plan to bring carts and dollies to assist in loading and unloading their wares and equipment. Parking for vehicles in the Tail Gate area is only allowed for bona fide tailgaters which does not include Vendors with indoor space. Please follow all directions from on-site Manassas HamFest staff for loading, unloading and parking, to avoid possible vehicle ticketing or towing by the Fairgrounds Management. 20170204
